The Chicago Retired Teachers Aid Fund is an organization whose purpose is to "assist indigent retired Chicago public school teachers through grants-in-aid and in such other financial matters as may be appropriate". The Fund's Board of Directors meets in January, April, July, and October of each year to review the cases of petitioners who are seeking financial assistance. Retired Chicago Public School teachers who are receiving a CTPF pension and wish to be considered as individuals seeking assistance from the Aid Fund must:

- a) complete an application form;
- b) provide a copy of his/her prior year's tax return;
- c) provide a copy of a Chicago Teachers Pension Fund payroll voucher for the current year;
- d) provide copies of current vouchers for payments received from sources other than the Chicago Teachers Pension Fund.

Once this has been completed the Aid Fund will review the petitioner's application and advise the individual as to his/her eligibility for assistance. Inasmuch as the Aid Fund meets quarterly, it is appropriate to submit the necessary documents for consideration at least one month prior to the Fund's next quarterly meeting. Annual fiscal updates are required.

The Aid Fund is able to make 'grants-in-aid' to retired Chicago public school teacher pensioners based upon their needs due to the generosity of others who make donations as well as others who make bequests to the Fund through bequests, trusts, and wills. Contributions to the Chicago Retired Teachers Aid Fund are fully tax deductible.

If you or someone of your acquaintance who is a retired Chicago Public School educator is in need of fiscal assistance, the individual should consider applying for a grant. Our Fund helps CTPF pensioners with very low pensions to access the basic goods and services needed to live.
